Promoters Conditions

1. The promoter is the Nottinghamshire ASA
2. All communication will be electronic via the website www.notts-swimming.co.uk or email as appropriate.
3. The competition is open to swimmers who are members of any Nottinghamshire club. Swimmers with a National Qualifying Time in any event are excluded from the competition.
4. All events are 'Open' but swimmers must meet the current 2013 County qualifying times and have not achieved a National time in the events entered.
5. The 400m Freestyle event shall be limited to 4 heats male and 4 heats female.
6. Swimmers may enter a maximum of 4 events.
7. Entries must be submitted by the club gala coordinator who is responsible for entering the swims electronically using the Sportsystems Entry Manager Program. Individual entries will not be accepted.
8. Entries received and processed will be listed on the website as they are received. A draft programme will be published on the website as soon as possible after the closing date.
9. The club gala coordinator is responsible for communicating with the swimmers, checking the processed entries and reporting any problems or errors to the gala administrator.
10. Swimmers who wish to withdraw from events must notify the gala administrator no later than the start of the morning warm up for **all** of the day's events. This can be done by email to **withdraw@notts-swimming.co.uk** or **text message** to **0772 532 0970**
11. The promoter reserves the right to limit entries should the gala capacity be exceeded. This will be achieved by rejecting the slowest times taking into account the number and the ages of the swimmers in each event.
12. There will be **NO** Photography on site and the capturing of any images whilst in the venue is strictly prohibited.
13. Any question arising, for which these conditions do not provide, shall be determined by the promoter.
