Promoters Conditions

1. The promoter is the Nottinghamshire A.S.A.
2. All communication will be electronic via the website www.notts-swimming.co.uk or email as appropriate.
3. The competition is open to swimmers who are members of any Swim England Affiliated Club.
4. All events are 'Open' with mixed ages, but results and awards will be issued in each age band: 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15/Over.
5. Awards not collected on the day will be forfeited.
6. All events will be seeded in time order with the last heat of each event spearheaded.
7. The 400m Freestyle events may be limited on heats depending on overall session running time.
8. Although there are no qualification times for this competition, entrants must submit a time for entry, but be lower than our upper limit times as published to be accepted for this competition.
9. Entries must be submitted by the club gala coordinator who is responsible for entering the swims electronically using the Sportsystems Entry Manager Program. Entry Times are downloaded automatically by the entry manager program, this time is the fastest time available and may be a converted time. Rankings will look back 1 year from the date of competition. If no time is available, then an estimated time may be used.
10. Entries received and processed will be listed on the website as they are received.
11. Entries are welcome from Para-Swimmers with a valid classification. Entry times must be submitted for the purposes of seeding, but the times do not need to meet any qualifying standards. Para-Swimmer's swim inclusive within the able-bodied programme and seeded on their entry time. The decision to accept such entries will be at the discretion of the promoter. There will be no para specific awards for this meet.
12. The club gala coordinator is responsible for communicating with the swimmers, checking the processed entries, and reporting any problems or errors to the gala administrator within 1 week of submitting the entries. Submitted times will not be updated unless an administrative error has been made by Nottinghamshire ASA.
13. Swimmers who wish to withdraw from events must notify the gala administrator no later than the start of the warmup for events in that session. This can be done by using the online withdrawal form. Withdrawals made after the closing date for entries will not be entitled to a refund.
14. If the meet is cancelled for matters beyond our control, all entry fees and coaches pass payments will be refunded. No other costs will be considered.
15. The promoter reserves the right to limit entries should the gala capacity be exceeded. The meet is a first come first served meet and entries will be taken until we are full on time and then only on a one-by-one basis to fill all lanes in all heats.
16. There may be a secondary strobe available at this competition if needed. We must be informed in advance of the competition date if this is needed.
17. Any question arising, for which these conditions do not provide, shall be determined by the promoter.
